

## REGULAR SESSION

MARCH 27, 2006

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 27, 2006. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Turner, McCann, Irelan, and King. Brown was absent.

**AGENDA:** Motion by Irelan and seconded by McCann to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

**MINUTES:** Motion by Turner and seconded by McCann to approve the March 16, 2006 minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

**ENGINEER:** Scott Nixon, County Engineer, presented the weekly maintenance and activity report.  
**Utility Permit –** Motion by Turner and seconded by McCann to approve the utility permit for Southern Iowa Rural Water Association to install 1" black poly rural water line at a minimum depth of 5 feet under Nuthatch Ave. in Section 8 of Union Township. All voting aye, motion carried. **Utility Permit –** Motion by Turner and seconded by McCann to approve the utility permit for David W Tripp to install water line across 270th St in Section 32 of Platte Township. All voting aye, motion carried. **Tile Line Permit –** Motion by McCann and seconded by Irelan to approve application for Mike Brentnall to install two 8" tile line located in Lincoln Township Section 31, T73N R30W near Townline Road. All voting aye, motion carried. **Right of Way Discussion –** Nixon discussed the right of way over the Grand River on REA Road with the Board.

**CLAIMS:** Motion by McCann and seconded by Turner to approve the handwritten claims to Union County Health Insurance for \$9,889.39 and \$14,178.96. All voting aye, motion carried.

**TRANSFER RESOLUTION:** Motion by Irelan and seconded by Turner to approve **Resolution #28 FY05-06** – Now on this 27th day of March, 2006 the matter of an operating transfer comes before the Union County Board of Supervisors. Whereas it is desired to transfer monies from the Closure Fund (0029) to the Silo New Cell Fund (0028), and Whereas said operating transfer is in accordance with Section 331.432 of the Code of Iowa. Be And It Is Hereby Resolved that the sum of \$80,000 is ordered to be transferred from the Closure Fund to the Silo New Cell Fund, effective this 27th day of March, 2006. The Auditor is directed to correct her books accordingly, and to notify the Treasurer of this operating transfer accompanying the notification with a copy of this resolution and the record of its adoption. The change is effective this 27th day of March 2006. Roll call vote: McCann, aye; Irelan, aye; Turner, aye; King, aye; and Brown, absent. Motion carried.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Union County Board of Supervisors that the above described road be ordered vacated and closed.
