

**SPECIAL SESSION**

**August 8, 2006**

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in special session on Tuesday, August 8, 2006 in the Union County Courtroom. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Brown, Irelan, McCann, and King. Turner was absent.

**AGENDA:** Motion by Irelan and seconded by McCann to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

**LANDFILL DISCUSSION:** County Treasurer, Linda Marley explained the four different landfill funds and the interest that goes to three of the funds. The operating fund interest goes to the General Basic Fund per Iowa Code 12C.7. Creston Mayor, Mike Tamerius read a prepared statement to the Board. County Auditor, Sandy Hysell presented documents on what has been spent at the County level on roads, seeding, etc. on the landfill property which is owned by the County. The County also does not charge any rent for use of the land. The County has been Audited by the State for years and they have copies of all 28E Agreements, and according to the State, if the agreement states that the County is the fiscal agent and is to keep the books for Prairie Solid Waste and is silent on where the interest goes, it goes to the County's General Basic Fund per Iowa Code 12C.7. Prairie Solid Waste Coordinator, Leslie Goldsmith discussed the constant changes in the rules and regulations that the State sets every year. County Supervisors Chair, Mike King stated that the Board also works for all constituents of Union County and are also looking out for the best interest of all Cities in the County and rural people.
