

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, October 23, 2006. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: Irelan, McCann, Brown, and King. Turner was absent.

AGENDA: Motion by McCann and seconded by Irelan to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Irelan and seconded by McCann to approve the October 16, 2006 minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

Turner arrived at 9:15 a.m.

COURTHOUSE SECURITY: Motion by Irelan and seconded by Turner to approve the 2006 Courthouse Security Plan as presented by County Attorney, Tim Kenyon. Roll call vote: McCann, aye; Brown, aye; Turner, aye; Irelan, aye; and King, aye. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING – ROAD CLOSURE: The public hearing on the Road Closure opened at 10:00 a.m. The following were present: Mark Saylor, Jasmin Sloan, Scott Nixon, Dan Fogle, and Joanie Howe. Mr. Fogle voiced his opinion for closing the road and cited the unlawful dumping on the road. No other comments were received by the public, the Supervisors, or the Auditor's Office. The public hearing closed at 10:08 a.m. Motion by Turner and seconded by Irelan to approve **Resolution #15 FY06-07** – Whereas, Union County desires to classify certain roads on the area service system in the County to provide for a minimal level of maintenance and access by means of a gate or barrier and Whereas, the County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to specify certain roads within the County as Area Service "C" roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57: and Whereas, the only persons who will have access rights to the road shall be: 1. The owner, lessee, or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land. 2. The agent or employee of the owner, lessee or person in lawful possession of any adjoining land. 3. Any peace officer. 4. Any magistrate. 5. Any Public employee whose duty is to supervise the use or perform maintenance of the road. 6. Any agent or employee of any utility located upon the road. Whereas, the minimal level of maintenance will be as follows: 1. Blading. Blading or dragging will not be performed on a regular basis. 2. Snow and Ice Removal. Snow and ice will not be removed on a regular basis. Snow and ice will only be removed by request after all other roads are open and widened back and only during normal working hours. 3. Signing. Except for load limit postings for structures, signing will not be provided. ALL AREA SERVICE LEVEL C ROADS SHALL BE IDENTIFIED WITH A SIGN AT ALL POINTS OF ACCESS TO WARN THE PUBLIC OF LOWER LEVEL OF MAINTENANCE. 4. Weeds, Brush, and Trees. Mowing or spraying of weeds, cutting brush and tree removal will not be performed on a regular basis. Adequate sight distances will not be maintained. 5. Structures. Bridges and culvert may not be maintained to carry legal loads. Upon failure or loss, the replacement structure will be appropriate for the traffic thereon. 6. Road surfacing. There will be no surfacing materials applied to Area Service System C Roads on a regular basis. 7. Shoulders. Shoulders will not be maintained on a regular basis. 8. Crown. A crown will not be maintained on a regular basis. 9. Repairs. There will be no road repair on a regular basis. 10. Uniform width. Uniform width for the traveled portion of the road will not be maintained. 11. Inspections. Regular inspections will not be conducted. Therefore, Be It Resoled By The Union County Board Of Supervisors that this County does hereby established the road described as a Area Service "C" road, with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance. On Daisy Avenue, beginning at the Southeast Corner of Section 9-71-31, Platte Township, thence north approximately 5240 feet to a point located 40 feet south of the Northeast

Corner of Section 9-71-31, for a total distance of 0.99 miles. Roll call vote: Brown, aye; Turner, aye; McCann, aye; Irelan, aye; and King, aye. Motion carried.

ENGINEER: Scott Nixon, County Engineer, presented the weekly maintenance and activity report.
Grading Agreement – Motion by Irelan and seconded by Turner to approve the standard Grading Agreement entered into as of this 23rd day of October, 2006 by and between Ron Brownlee and Union County. The agreement can be viewed in the Auditor’s Office. All voting aye, motion carried.
