

REGULAR SESSION**SEPTEMBER 8, 2005**

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, September 8, 2005. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: McCann, Brown, Irelan, King, and Turner.

AGENDA: Motion by Brown and seconded by Irelan to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

ENGINEER: Scott Nixon, County Engineer, presented the weekly maintenance and activity report, the spray map, and rock map. **Utility Permit** – Motion by Brown and seconded by Irelan to approve the utility permit for Southern Iowa Rural Water Association to install 1” black poly rural water line under 150th St. at a minimum depth of 5’ from Section 25 to Section 36 in New Hope Township. All voting aye, motion carried. **DOT Agreement** – Motion by King and seconded by McCann for the Chair to sign the DOT Federal-aid Agreement (Agreement #405-STPS022, Project #STP-S-CO88(37)—5E-88) for REA Road (H-17) from Co.Rd. P-39 to Co. Rd. P-53. All voting aye, motion carried. **Engineer Contract Renewal** – Engineer Nixon discussed the renewal of his contract for another 3 years with the Board. No action was taken at this time.

LOCAL OPTION SALES AND SERVICES TAX FIRST INSTALLMENT CHECK: Motion by King and seconded by McCann to put 50% (\$16,347.32) in Secondary Roads Fund, 30% (\$9,808.39) in to Rural Basic Fund and 20% (\$6,538.94) in to the General Basic Fund. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by King and seconded by McCann to approve the August 29, 2005 minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

VOTING EQUIPMENT: Motion by King and seconded by Irelan to purchase the Diebold system from Matt Parrott and Sons, Inc. of Waterloo for \$106,532.50 for Voting Equipment and \$55,000.00 for in house programming. The Help America Vote Act Federal Funds will be reimbursing the County \$101,000.00 for the new election equipment. Roll call vote: Brown; aye, McCann; aye, Irelan; aye, King; aye, and Turner; aye. Motion carried.
