

ENTRANCE APPLICATION

Effective January 31, 2005, any new residential, commercial or field entrance, or any extensions thereto, shall require a permit approved by the Union County Engineer prior to installation.

For any new entrance or extension, the applicant is responsible for the installation of said entrance. The County Engineer's Office will determine the minimum size and length of new pipe required, dependent upon the size of drainage area and the width of entrance desired with the necessary side slopes. Minimum size of pipe to be installed shall be 18" in diameter, with a minimum of one foot of cover over the top of the pipe. The final location to be approved by the County Engineer based on appropriate sight distances and safety conditions.

Union County will be responsible for applying granular surfacing on one primary residential entrance to the right-of-way line. If the entrance is for a new residence, the granular surfacing will not be applied by Union County until the construction of residence is completed.

After installation has been completed by the applicant and approved by the County Engineer, it shall become the County's obligation to maintain it.

This application applies to all entrances with the exception of construction projects.
